HARRISBURG (PA) ALUMNI CHAPTER HISTORY

The following Brothers petitioned the Grand Board of Directors (April 18, 1960), Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., to establish an alumni chapter in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania to supervise the Pennsylvania State University chapter, the Delta Theta of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity. Inc. Charles T. Sampson, Jr. (Beta Psi); Barton A. Fields (Delta Theta/Philadelphia Alumni), Bennie I. Frey (Topeka Alumni); William R. Atkins (Alpha Psi/Pittsburgh Alumni); Leroy N. Craig (Alpha Theta); Harold W. Neighbors (Alpha Upsilon); H. Garnett Lee (Epsilon/Langston Alumni); Horatio F. Leftwich (Tau); Clarence Henderson (Pi/Philadelphia Alumni); and Robert J. Hanna (Delta Eta/Grand Chapter). NEP Polemarch was Brother Jackson W. Campbell for the chartering.

The Harrisburg Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. was chartered on May 28, 1960. The charter members were Attorney William Atkins, Leroy Craig, Barton Fields, Robert Hanna, Rev. Clarence Henderson, Rev. H. Garnett Lee, Horatio Leftwich and William Thompson. The chapter thrived until 1967 when many of the members who were government employees were relocated; thus, the chapter was inactive for three years.

With the assistance of Past Province Polemarch Albert Oliver, the chapter was reactivated. Members at the time were William Adkins, William Diggs, Michael Drake, Barton Fields, Homer Floyd, Donald Gibson, Ike Golden (Chapter Invisible), Rev. Clarence Henderson, Steve Howard, Robert Jackson, Rev. H. Garnett Lee, Horatio Leftwich, Willie Nelson (Chapter Invisible), Attorney Richard Scott (Chapter Invisible) and Herman B. Thomas, Jr. (Chapter Invisible)

In April 1971, Harrisburg Alumni answered the roll at the 40th Annual Northeastern Province Council that was held in Hartford, Connecticut. Delegates to this meeting were Polemarch Robert Jackson, Michael Drake, Ike Golden, Willie Nelson (Chapter Invisible) and Herman B. Thomas, Jr (Chapter Invisible). Harrisburg Alumni has not missed a single roll call since. Some ten years later, Harrisburg Alumni hosted its first Province Council Meeting in 1981, and again in 1993.
